

Trajectory Schema

What you might see....

Your child may enjoy running, throwing, bat and ball games, knocking over towers.

Possible problems you may encounter.....

this may turn into inappropriate throwing of objects, running into people or things, jumping from furniture or playground equipment, kicking or punching.

I can help my child's Personal, social and emotional development by.....

developing turn taking and sharing with ball games. helping children manage risk by using playground equipment safely

I can help my child's physical development by.....

providing a safe environment for my child to explore this interest. Provide finger paints and large sheets of paper for your child to explore mark making using their whole body movements. Provide climbing, slides, ramps, guttering to make water walls, bats and balls. Trampolines

I can help my child's communication and language by.....

reading stories such as The Runaway Train by Benedict Blathwayt and My Mun and Dad make me Laugh by Nick Sharrat which are about journeys. Use positional language and language associated with movement to build vocabulary.

I can help my child's understanding of the world by.....

Your child may show an interest in journeys and maps. Take trips to the shops or go on buses and trains. They may have an interest in space or space travel. Sand and water play using sieves and funnels.

Numbers and number lines. Your child may enjoy rolling out dough, or mashing potatoes. They may enjoy sawing and hammering. Providing block play for building towers.

I can help my child's self expression and aesthetic development by.....

play with gloop. Rhythm and movement such as the Grand Old Duke of York. Instruments such as drums for banging and percussion instruments for waving
